


# SETTING UP A HENRI STUDIO 4046F3 FOUNTAIN

- 1) The 4046F3 Fountain has a high center of gravity, so make sure to set the bottom Pool on a firm and flat foundation.
- 2) Fit the smaller rubber stopper around the pump cord, about 10" from the pump. Slip the cord through the Pool's center hole and pull out the bottom toward your electric connection. Push the stopper tightly into the hole.
- 3) Thread the smaller adapter into the pump top and push the tube over the barb. Install the flow restrictor about ten inches up the tube, tightening just enough to keep in place. The restrictor can be used later to reduce the water flow if that is desired.
- 4) Have two people (at least) place the Flare Spill Top in the Pool. While one person tips it, the other needs to insert the tube up from the bottom. Pull the tube so it just clears the top edge of the Spill Top and insert the larger stopper around the tube, just above the cast-in coupling. Now, set the Spill Top down, enclosing the pump. Push the stopper tightly into the coupling.
- 5) Again, while one person holds the top Finial concrete piece, the other should thread in the larger of the adapters and then mount the open end of the tube on the adapter barb. Then, set the Finial inside the Flare Spill Top.
- 6) Shims are included to help you make your fountain level. Either use a level or (better yet) fill the top fountain pieces with water. Apply shims under each piece as necessary to level.
- 7) Fill the Pool with water. Read your pump instructions. Then, plug your pump into a GFCI protected circuit and enjoy your new Henri Fountain.



## **IMPORTANT – WINTER CARE**

Winter ice build-up can cause damage to concrete statuary. Follow these tips to reduce winter weathering to your fountain:

- \* Disconnect power to pumps and lights.
- \* Remove plugs / stopper in all fountain bowls to open drains and let all moisture out. Keep drains open throughout winter.
- \* Place an absorbant material like burlap, blankets, etc. inside vases/bowls and cover all with a Henri fountain cover.
- \* Do not allow snow or ice to build up on or against the concrete. Remove snow before it turns to ice. Do not use salt or chemical ice removers as these may damage concrete.

By following these simple and sensible precautions during the winter season, you will protect your fountain for years of beauty and enjoyment.
