
## SETTING UP THE 5279F3

- 1) Set the 7280 Pedestal on your prepared site. Turn the mouse hole (*near the bottom*) for the power cord toward your power supply. Make sure the pedestal is level.
- 2) Gently set the 6280 Bowl on the pedestal. Place the pump in the center of the bowl. Push its power cord into the center hole, down through the pedestal, and out the mouse hole toward your power supply.
- 3) Insert the Pump/Tube Adapter into the top of the pump. Push the Water Tube onto the pump/tube adapter. Slip the Flow Restrictor onto the upper half of the tube, tightening it just enough for it to hold in place. (*This can be tightened later if you want to reduce your water flow.*) Place the 5279P Pedestal into the bowl, around the tube and pump.
- 4) Thread the Barbed Adapter into the underside of the 5279T Finial. Lower the finial into place on the bowl unit, pushing the open end of the water tube over the barbed adapter before setting it down.
- 5) Fill the bowl with water. Read pump instructions. Turn on the pump. If it does not immediately begin working, there may be an "airlock" within the impeller chamber. Simply unplug and plug in a few times and it should start.

Make sure to place your fountain on a firm and level surface which will not settle. Note: Always follow local electrical codes and use a 110V GFCI protected outlet. Do not let children climb on fountain.



## IMPORTANT - WINTER CARE

Winter ice build-up can cause damage to concrete statuary. Follow these tips to reduce winter weathering to your fountain:

- \* Disconnect power to pumps.
- \* Remove plugs/stoppers in all fountain bowls to open drains and let all moisture out. Keep drains open throughout winter.
- \* Cover with a Henri fountain cover. Keep tight and do not let snow or water collect in sagging areas.
- \* Do not allow snow or ice to build up on or against the concrete. Remove snow before it turns to ice. Do not use antifreeze, salt or chemical ice removers as these may damage concrete.
